## **Repeat Prescriptions**

Kindly note that it is your responsibility to ensure you have a sufficient supply of repeat medications. This is especially true during weekends and public holidays. Make sure that you check your medicine supply regularly.

You can order your repeat prescription via email, NHS App, Patience Access, in person at surgery or through your local pharmacy. If you have run out of any medication which you take regularly, you can secure an emergency supply by requesting this via NHS 111 Online.

To allow our doctors and prescription clerks to process your request efficiently, we now require 3 working days to complete any prescription request. Completing a prescription is not an easy task. This involves the clerk carefully checking your record and the GP doing the same and signing this off in between clinics

#### **Zero Tolerance Policy**

A gentle reminder that Abbeywell Surgery operates a zero tolerance policy and we will not stand abuse against staff. Any such behaviour will see a warning letter sent to the patient and a repetition might see you removed from the practice list.
